At present, consideration for the welfare of others is more important than ever

Our goal is that everyone who chooses to spend time with us will feel as safe and secure as possible, even at a time when we are faced with an ongoing pandemic. At 7A we are careful to follow the latest recommendations and guidelines from the Swedish authorities, and we constantly monitor developments to ensure that we are managing the situation in the best possible manner. This information leaflet contains a summary of the measures we are currently taking to reduce the risk of the spread of infection at our premises.

We encourage our guests and co-workers to maintain a safe and respectful distance to each other, and to pay particular attention to good hand hygiene. At all our facilities we have a policy of zero tolerance with regard to symptoms associated with COVID-19. This means that, in accordance with the Swedish Public Health Agency's recommendations, all guests and co-workers at 7A should stay home at the slightest sign of illness or other symptoms associated with COVID-19.

Together we can reduce the spread of infection

We need to work together to create a safe and secure work environment at our facilities. When you are present in our premises, please remind your colleagues and visitors to follow the recommendations and guidelines from the Swedish authorities, as this is the best way to protect yourselves and others from being infected with COVID-19.

Here are some important things we can all do:

- ✓ Wash your hands often and thoroughly with soap and warm water for at least 20 seconds. More hygiene advice is available here.
- ✓ Use hand disinfectant if soap and water are not available.
- ✓ Avoid bodily contact with other people.
- ✓ Keep your hands away from your eyes, nose and mouth.
- ✓ Cough and sneeze into your elbow, as this reduces the risk of infecting your hands and spreading infection in your surroundings.
- ✓ Stay home if you feel sick or have symptoms such as a runny nose, coughing or fever, even if the symptoms are only mild.
- ✓ Wait at least two days after you feel well again before returning to work.
- ✓ Avoid visiting people over the age of 70 belong to the primary risk group for serious illness due to COVID-19.
- ✓ Maintain a safe and respectful distance to other people in public areas.
- ✓ Avoid travel during peak hours.



Show consideration by keeping your distance in elevators

Avoid crowding in an elevator by using the stairs when possible. Not only does this protect your own and other people's health, you will also be doing the climate a favour in the process! If your office is located on a high floor of the building, perhaps you can at least take the stairs on the way down?



Ride your bike to the office

If you are able to ride your bike to the office instead of adding to the congestion on public transport, there is a bicycle room or bicycle parking directly adjacent to or nearby all our facilities. 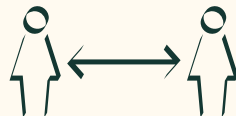
Those of us who work at 7A

At the same time, many of our employees are needed on site as we provide an important service to our tenants and guests at our premises.

These are the principles we follow when we are at the office. Perhaps you may also find this information useful? Feel free to share it with others!

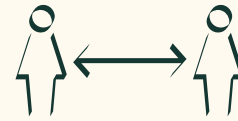
- ✓ Maintain a safe distance between desks.
- ✓ Limit the number of people in a room at the same time, so that everyone can sit at an arm's length distance to each other.
- ✓ Maintain a safe and respectful distance to each other.
- ✓ Avoid the use of public transport during peak hours.
- ✓ Plan your travel carefully, and adapt your travel times to avoid congestion to the greatest extent possible.
- ✓ Avoid bodily contact, and don't hug or shake hands with other people.
- ✓ Wash your hands often and thoroughly, and use hand sanitiser regularly.



Hygiene and cleaning

We have adjusted the cleaning routines in our common areas, including the wiping of all contact surfaces with disinfectant continually during the day. For example, this includes:

- ✓ Taps
- ✓ Coffee machines and coffee stations
- ✓ Keypads
- ✓ Door handles



Maintaining distances in common areas

We have made adjustments to ensure that fewer people than usual will be present in our common areas at the same time. For example, this includes:

- ✓ Less furniture in common areas such as kitchens, lounges and conference rooms.
- ✓ Distance markings to help you maintain an appropriate distance.
- ✓ Increased access to our areas, in order to avoid crowding to the greatest extent possible.



Equipment for increased safety and security

We encourage everyone to use hand sanitiser regularly as a complement to washing your hands with soap and water. Face masks and disposable gloves are available at all receptions and there is hand sanitiser available at various locations throughout our premises, for example next to:

- ✓ Entranceways and reception areas
- ✓ Toilets
- ✓ Conference rooms
- ✓ Printers
- ✓ Common areas such as kitchens and lounges

We have put up signs at our premises to remind everyone to show respect and consideration for others, for example by:

- ✓ Maintaining a safe and respectful distance to each other
- ✓ Choosing alternatives that avoid crowding
- ✓ Washing your hands often and thoroughly
- ✓ Using hand sanitiser regularly
